## 1st, 2nd, 3rd warnings... Stop and Think note home

This past week, I made a concerted effort to *not* give formal warnings to students for behavior that needed fixing. I verbally reminded, redirected, and had one-on-one conversations as I want to create a positive relationship with each child. This week, I will review Ms. Maltz's system for *carpet behavior specifically* with the class and use the 1st warning, 2nd warning, 3rd warning and then a Stop and Think note will go home to explain what happened if needed. Please use any of these notices that come home as a learning opportunity to review and reinforce expectations while understanding that the focus is carpet behavior and how good carpet behavior helps school to be more fun and enjoyable for our classroom community!
