Progress Reports- none for Kindergarten

There are no progress reports for Kindergarten at this time in the year. I will be giving a 3rd Quarter assessment that covers sight words to date, letters/sounds, counting by 5s, 10s, simple addition and subtraction, and filling in the missing number. I will send out a notice when this is coming home in their folders- it should be before spring break. Please note that this is one way to measure your child's academic progress, but progress in kindergarten is much more complex than just these academic markers. It is important that we see progress of some sort (academically and socially), overall enjoyment of school, and a confidence in their learning. Learning is also not always linear.
